



Environmental and occupational health policy statement


Occupational health, the environment and quality occupy a position of considerable consequence in company policy as a whole. This is implemented by compliance with the relevant legislation and regulations and by the application of management principles as these are expressed in the ISO 14001:2004 standard. BNI constantly endeavours to meet these requirements and standards and to improve its compliance where possible. Continuous improvement is also BNI's objective with regard to the other aspects of the environment and occupational health that are capable of being influenced. BNI wishes to produce sustainably and accepts its social responsibility towards all interested parties.

BNI has made great efforts in recent years to manage the environmental aspects of its operations. These efforts have led to impressive results, such as substantial savings on natural gas consumption and the internal recycling of residual printing pastes. In the field of occupational health, much attention has been given to the application of safety instructions and the creation of the right workplace. Furthermore, BNI endeavours to use materials that are less harmful to man and the environment.

BNI continues to pursue its chosen course of action and is aiming to reduce its consumption of energy and water and to facilitate the recycling of waste materials. Where occupational health is concerned, BNI focuses on maintaining the current safety level in relation to growing efficiency and on the further increase of staff involvement in the management of occupational health. Staff are also expected to work together as one team, to be proactive and take the initiative, and to work on continuous improvement.

The management board of BNI provides both technical and organizational resources to achieve these goals and to comply with legislation and regulations, and with other requirements endorsed by BNI. BNI makes active efforts in the interests of an open relationship with the authorities, local residents and other stakeholders and this policy statement is available on request to stakeholders and interested parties as a consequence.
